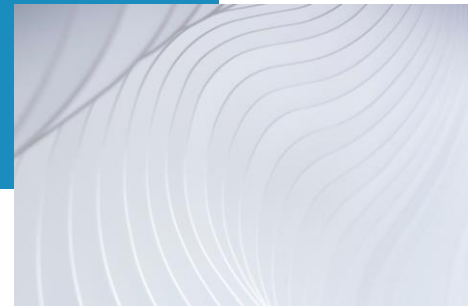

# Public Health Forschung: Was verstehen wir darunter?

- **Bevölkerungsgesundheit** muss im Fokus + mit Gesundheitsdeterminanten verknüpft sein (Dhalgreen-Whitehead, 1991)
- **Health in all policies** Ansatz, soweit möglich
  - Bedingt einen sektorenübergreifenden approach
  - Was nicht: Klinische, med.-kurative, monodisziplinäre Forschung
- Zielgruppen: prinzipiell **alle Bevölkerungsgruppen erreichen**
  - zugleich Zielgruppenorientierung wichtig (Bsp. Covid-19, Adipositas ...)

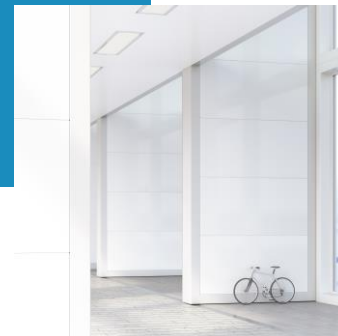
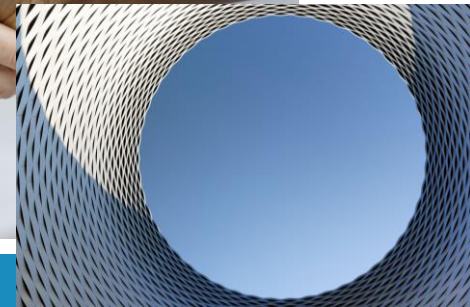
